

Downtown Savannah Bicycle Amenities



What you should know about riding bicycles downtown:

- Cyclists must follow the same traffic regulations as motorists. This includes obeying stop signs and traffic signals.
- Cyclists should always ride with traffic, not against it.
- Riding through downtown squares and on the sidewalks of Broughton Street is illegal and carries a fine of more than \$100.
- Cyclists should be careful outside of the "door zone," so that they can avoid opening car doors.
- Night riding requires bicycles to display a white light visible from 300 feet on the front and red reflector on the rear.
- Helmets are legally required for riders and passengers under the age of 16 and strongly recommended for adult riders.
